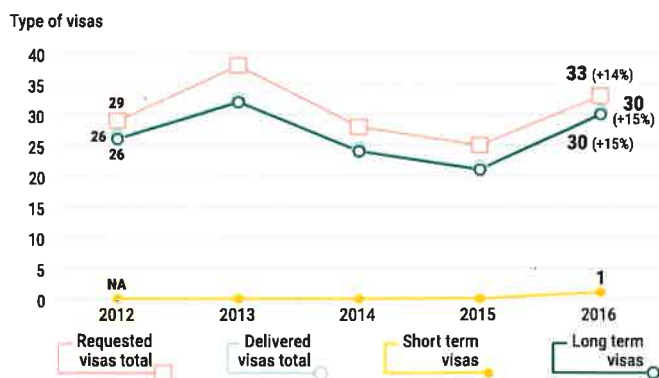

## Mobility in France (MESRI)<sup>(2)</sup>

**In 2016-2017, France hosted 205 students from Bosnia-Herzegovina, 55% of whom are women.**  
158 (77%) registered at universities, 10 (5%) at Business Schools, 7 (3%) at Engineering Schools and 30 (15%) at other schools (*Grandes Ecoles, Art Schools, Specialized Schools...*).

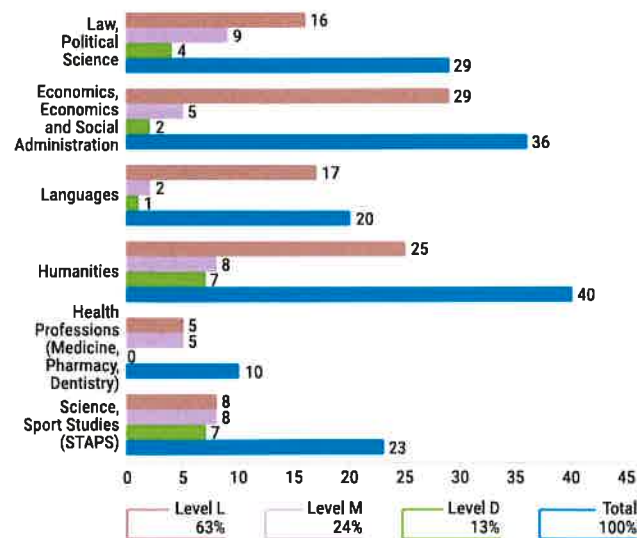
### Requested and Delivered Student Visas from 2012 to 2016<sup>(3)</sup>
